Dear NGO Representative,

Subject: Follow-up to the decision of the Economic and Social Council

I am pleased to inform you that the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) at its Coordination and management meeting of 25 July 2017 adopted the recommendation of the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) to grant **special** consultative status to your organization, **International Human Rights Council**. On behalf of all staff of the Non-Governmental Organizations Branch/OESC/DESA, please accept our heartfelt congratulations.

Consultative status for an organization enables it to actively engage with ECOSOC and its subsidiary bodies, as well as with the United Nations Secretariat, programmes, funds and agencies in a number of ways. In order to better understand this relationship, we take this opportunity to provide some critical information about the **privileges** that consultative status with ECOSOC confers on your organization, as well as the **obligations** that your organization will be required to meet under this relationship. **We therefore urge you to take the time to carefully review the information provided below.**

A. Privileges and benefits of consultative status

1) ECOSOC Resolution 1996/31

- Arrangements for consultations with NGOs are regulated by ECOSOC resolution 1996/31, adopted by the Council on 25 July 1996. It provides information on ways to participate in the work of the Council, including opportunities to organizations such as yours to consult with Member States and the United Nations system at large, based on the nature and scope of work that your organization undertakes. Consultative relationship with NGOs also enables the Council or one of its bodies to seek expert information or advice from organizations with special competence in a subject matter;

During the visits of the National Human Rights Commission to various States in the country, the NGOs and Human Rights Defenders have drawn the attention of the Commission to the functional environment in the States being not very conducive to their work. They have alleged that functionaries of NGOs and Human Rights Defenders are being threatened and some times have been physically manhandled by the State authorities. It has been stated by them that they live in constant fear of being implicated in false cases. These issues have also been discussed with the State Government officers during the Commission meetings, Open hearings and Camp sittings.

It would, therefore, be of immense help if State Government functionaries are sensitized about the problems being faced by NGOs and Human Rights Defenders. The latter should be treated as partners in bringing about a positive change in the human rights environment in the States.


The above trust has been constituted by a Trust Deed dated 16.11.2010. The Trust has been registered with the Asst. Charity Commissioner, Mumbai on 18.11.2010 vide registration No. 6716(Delhi). It has filed an application for registration u/s. 12A(a) of Income Tax Act, 1961 in the prescribed Form No. 10A on 17.10.2017. After considering the materials available on record, the applicant trust is granted registration w.e.f. A.Y.2018-19.


2. No change in the terms of Trust Deed of the Trust shall be effected without due procedure of law i.e. by order of the jurisdictional High Court and its intimation shall be given immediately to this office. The registering authority reserves the right to consider whether any such alteration in objects would be consistent with the definition of "charitable purpose" under the Act and in conformity with the requirement of continuity of registration.
3. The name of the Trust/Institution has been entered at No.49954 in the Register of Applications u/s. 12A(a) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 maintained in this office.
4. The registration u/s.12AA of the I.T. Act, 1961 does not mean that the Trust/Institution is automatically entitled to exemption. The right to exemption shall be examined and decided upon by the Assessing Officer (A.O.) with reference to the activities undertaken, compliance with various statutory and other requirements, etc. on year to year basis, without prejudice to the fact of grant of mere 'in-principle' registration by this Order.
5. The registration u/s.12AA of the I.T. Act, 1961 does not automatically confer any right on the donors to claim deduction u/s.80G.
6. The registration so granted is liable to be cancelled at any point of time, if the registering authority is satisfied that activities of the Trust/Institution are not genuine or are not being carried out in accordance with the objects of the Trust/Institution.
7. This certificate cannot be used as a basis for claiming non-deduction of tax at source in respect of investments etc. relating to the Trust/Institution.
8. The Trust/Institution shall furnish a return of income every year within the time limit prescribed under the Act.
9. The Trust/Institution should quote the PAN in all its communications with the Department.
10. The income as also the corpus of the Institution should be applied to and for public charitable purposes only and subject to such conditions of limitations if any, as may from time to time be laid down in the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 and Income-tax Act, 1961 or any other Act governing the Public Charitable Trust.
11. The Institution/Trust may apply the trust funds for charitable purposes outside India only in cases where the Institution/Trust tends to promote International Welfare in which India is interested and prior approval is obtained by way of a General or special order from the Central Board of Direct Taxes, Government of India in terms of proviso to Section 11(1)(c) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
12. The Institution/Trust shall operate/open Bank Account only in the name of the Trust and not in the name of any of the trustees.
13. In the event of dissolution/winding up of the Trust /Institution, the entire Institution funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust/Institution. The assets recovery as on the date of dissolution/winding-up shall under no circumstances be distributed in any manner to any of the Board of Trustees or founder or member of their relatives or related concerns, but the same shall be transferred to another Trust /Society/Association/Institution whose objects are similar to those of this trust/society/Association/Institution after obtaining previous approval of the Charity Commissioner/Civil Court or any other competent authority in accordance with the provisions contained in the BPT Act, 1950.
